

## American Heritage 2021-2022 Scholarship

Global Doing Good awards scholarships in varying amounts for students traveling on American Heritage trips with Global Travel Alliance. The scholarships are awarded based upon the quality of a written essay. The essays should focus on the values of service, integrity, or leadership.

- To be considered for a scholarship, students must write an essay that demonstrates an understanding of <u>one</u> of the three values: service, integrity or leadership.
- Essays must be submitted electronically via the group leader for your trip. Essays
  must be sent as an attachment or in the body of the email to:

- Scholarship funding is available only to students who are enrolled or who are considering to enroll in the American Heritage program or select programs.
- The final deadline for submission is Thursday, **January 24, 2022**
- Essays will be reviewed and awarded by **February 11, 2022**

## **Directions:**

Write an essay about a person that exemplifies service, integrity or leadership from your own experiences and observations. Please be specific. For example, how has this person demonstrated integrity in your opinion? Provide examples. Don't forget to include your own beliefs about the topic. Describe it as it pertains to your life.

- Essays should be 1-2 pages long, double-spaced.
- Please remember to include at the top of the essay:
  - your school
  - the name of your trip leader
  - o your name, home address, phone number and email address
- Essays MUST be submitted by your group leader as an attachment, via email to scholarships@globaldoinggood.org

## Awards:

As a stipulation for receiving the scholarship, winners will be required to write a short note of thanks to the anonymous donors that make these awards possible. Additionally, scholarship awardees will be required to write a one page reflection about their trip upon completion.
