



Welcome to the 2023 Global Doing Good American Heritage Scholarship Application!

Global Doing Good awards scholarships in varying amounts for students traveling on American Heritage trips with Global Travel Alliance. The scholarships are awarded based upon various factors, including quality of the written essay. The essays should focus on the values of service, integrity, or leadership.

- To be considered for a scholarship students must write an essay that demonstrates an understanding of one of the following three values: service, integrity or leadership.
- **Essays must be sent as an attachment via email to:**
scholarships@globaldoinggood.org. Please 'cc' the trip leader in the email.
- Scholarship funding is available only to students who are enrolled or who are considering to enroll in the American Heritage program or select programs.
- The final deadline for submission is **January 15, 2023**
- Essays will be reviewed and awarded by **February 1, 2023**

Directions:

Compose an essay about a person that exemplifies service, integrity or leadership from your own experiences and observations. Please be specific. For example, how has this person demonstrated integrity in your opinion? Provide examples. Don't forget to include your own beliefs about the topic. Describe it as it pertains to your life.

- Essays should be 250-500 words, double-spaced.
- Please remember to include at the top of the essay:
 - your school
 - the name of your trip leader
 - your name, home address, phone number and email address
- Essays **MUST** be submitted as an attachment via email to scholarships@globaldoinggood.org with your group leader as a recipient.

Awards:

As a stipulation for receiving the scholarship, winners will be requested to compose a short note of thanks to the anonymous donors that make these awards possible. Additionally, scholarship awardees will be requested to write a one page reflection about their trip upon completion.
