2024 Travel Scholarship Application

Global Doing Good awards scholarships in varying amounts for middle school students traveling to Washington, D.C. and the historic East Coast. The scholarships are awarded based upon the quality of a written essay as well as need. The essays should focus on the values of service, integrity, or leadership.

- To be considered for a scholarship, students must write an essay that demonstrates an understanding of one of the three values: service, integrity or leadership.
- **Essays must be submitted as an attachment via email** either by the traveler or the trip's group leader. Please submit essays to: scholarships@globaldoinggood.org
- Scholarship funding is available only to students who are enrolled or who are considering enrolling in a 2024 travel program.
- The final deadline for submission is **November 15, 2023**.
- Essays will be reviewed and awarded by **December 1, 2023**.

Directions:

Write an essay about a person that exemplifies service, integrity or leadership from your own experiences and observations. Please be specific. For example, how has this person demonstrated integrity in your opinion? Provide examples. Don't forget to include your own beliefs about the topic. Describe it as it pertains to your life. Applicants should also include relevant need-based content for the review panel to consider.

- Essays should be 1-2 pages long, double-spaced.
- Please remember to include at the top of the essay:
 - School information: full name of school and school address
 - Trip information: name of teacher/trip leader, trip leader email address, travel dates, and destination(s)
 - Traveler information: Traveler name, grade, parent/guardian email and phone number
- Essays **MUST** be submitted by you or your teacher/group leader as an attachment, via email to scholarships@globaldoinggood.org

Awards:

As a stipulation for receiving the scholarship, winners will be required to write a short note of thanks to the anonymous donors that make these awards possible. Additionally, scholarship awardees will be required to write a one page reflection about their trip upon completion.
